
- **Summative Assignments:** There is no late-work penalty for mastery assignments turned in within the two-week grace period.
- Formative Assignments: Your teacher may or may not accept late non-mastery assignments for full credit. Look at your teacher's syllabus for more information.



Formative

• Assignments that are used throughout a unit to check in with your understanding before the Summative assignment.





Summative

- Assessment that measures mastery of standards.
- Assignments in this category are eligible for reassessment.
- Before your second chance, you will need to prepare based on your teacher's requirements.
- There will be no reassessment opportunity for summative assignments on which a student receives teacher feedback for improvement before the final summative submission (i.e. feedback offered to students throughout the writing process of an essay).

ROLLING GRADEBOOK

- Think of end-of-quarter report cards as quick snapshots of your learning so far. Final grades are the only ones that count towards your GPA.
- Instead of averaging each of the 4 quarter grades, rolling gradebooks are set up so the final course grade is determined by averaging of all the assignments and assessments throughout the year.
