

The School Board is accepting applications for the Student Leadership Development Program, open to any high school freshman, sophomore, or junior in good academic standing. The program is for students interested in a future in law, government or public policy. Twelve students will be chosen to work closely with the School Board to how FCPS is governed and will give the students opportunities to participate on various advisory committees to the School Board, and even to seek election as the student representative on the School Board.

The Student Leaders attend and participate in:

- Group orientation (December 2024)
- School Board Forum or Committee Meeting (January March 2025)
- School Board Work Session (January March 2025)
- Mock Forum (Spring 2025)
- Mock Work Session (Spring 2025)
- Program Completion Ceremony (June 2025)

<u>Applications</u> for this year's program are available on the FCPS website under School Board. Students should submit the brief application, program requirements form, and one-page statement of interest to their principals by **September 30, 2024**. Principals will submit applications to the School Board Office by **October 15, 2024**. Each School Board member will select one student from their magisterial district, and the at-large members will select one student from all the applications received. The selected student leaders and remaining applicants will be notified by email by November 15, 2024.

Principals are encouraged to help advertise the program in the following ways:

- 1. Include it in the daily announcements.
- 2. Request that the government teachers provide the information to their freshman, sophomores, and juniors.
- 3. Request that the guidance counselors and career center specialists provide the information to their underclassmen.

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STUDENT LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM 2024-2025 APPLICATION FORM

Students are invited to participate in the School Board's Student Leadership Development Program to gain a better understanding of how the school system is governed. Any high school or alternative high school freshman, sophomore, or junior in good academic standing is eligible. *Students who are interested in participating must submit a one-page statement of interest to their principal before September 30, 2024.* The statement should include: 1) why the student is applying; 2) what he or she hopes to accomplish by participating in the leadership development program; and 3) whether he or she intends to run for the student representative position on the School Board in the future.

The principal will evaluate the statement of interest, as well as the student's academic, extracurricular, and disciplinary record, and nominate no more than five students. Students should be recommended because of their overall commitment, interest, enthusiasm, and leadership potential viewed in totality. Thus, a C average student with some disciplinary infractions but who shows great potential as a leader could participate in the program.

The principal will forward the applications of their school's nominees to the School Board Office via <u>SBStudentLeadership@fcps.edu</u> by October 15, 2024. The appropriate district and at-large Board members will then consider and select 12 students for the program. Students will be notified of their selection status via email on November 15, 2024.
